

ENROLMENTS SEPTEMBER 2019.—ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SCHOOL

Enrolments For Marino Parish AND Siblings From Other Parishes are on the **15th, 16th and 17th January 2019** between 10 am – 12 noon in the school.

Requirements for enrolments are a birth certificate and 2 documents stating residential address for those who reside in the Parish. You must also have your child's PPS number. These documents must state the full name of parent/guardian and full address, and at least one of these documents must be dated within the three months prior to enrolment date. Examples of acceptable documents include (but are not limited to): Driver's licence, utility bills, P60, P45, Tax certificates, voting cards, copies of electoral register records, Bank statements.

Applications cannot be accepted if the above requirements are not brought. To qualify for Parish enrolment you must either own or rent a dwelling in the Parish. **Enrolments from other parishes are on the 22nd, 23rd and 24th of January 2019** between 10 am – 12 noon.

Requirements for enrolments are a birth certificate and your child's PPS number. Applications cannot be accepted if the above requirements are not brought. 27th January is the closing date for enrolments and NO applications will be taken after this date
