Palm Sunday Gospel A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke

Jesus went on to Jerusalem. When he got close, he sent two of his disciples on ahead and told them: 'Go in to next town. When you enter it, you will see a donkey tied up. Untie it and bring it here to me. If anyone asks you why you are taking it, just say: the Master needs it and will send it back directly'.

They gave him the answer Jesus had told them and the owner let them go. They took the donkey back to Jesus, threw their cloaks on its back and he sat on it.
