Holy Saturday Gospel

A reading from the Holy Gospels according to John and Matthew(adapted)

After Jesus had died on the cross, one of his friends called Joseph of Arimathaea asked



Pilate if he could remove Jesus' body from the cross. Pilate gave him permission and so some of the followers of Jesus came and took his body away. They wrapped it with spices in linen cloths, as was the Jewish burial custom.

At the place where Jesus had died there was a garden and in this garden, a new tomb which had never been used. They laid Jesus there and rolled a very large stone to block the entrance to the tomb.

Some of the Jewish leaders also went to Pilate. They said: "We remember that when Jesus was alive he said 'After 3 days I will rise from the dead'. We want you to give the order for his tomb to be guarded closely in case his followers come and steal the body. Then they could tell people he had risen from the dead".

Pilate said, 'Take some soldiers and go and guard the tomb'. So they all went to the tomb and made it safe from thieves. They did this by sealing the stone in the entrance and putting soldiers there to guard it.
