Easter Sunday Gospel

A reading from the Holy Gospels according to John and Matthew(adapted)



It was very early on Sunday morning and still dark when Mary of Magdala and the other women set out for the tomb . They had been saying to one another, “Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance to the tomb”. But when they looked they could see that the stone – which was very big – had already been rolled back.

And there sitting on the stone was the Angel of the Lord, who had descended from heaven. His face was like lightning and his robe was white as snow. They were terrified. But the angel spoke and said, “There is no need for you to be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here, because he has risen as he said he would. Come and see the place where he lay, then go quickly and tell his disciples, “He has risen from the dead and now he is going before you to Galilee. It is there you will see him”. Filled with awe and great joy, the women came quickly away from the tomb and ran to tell the disciples. This story of theirs seemed pure nonsense and the disciples did not believe them. However Peter and John went running to the tomb. They saw the stone rolled back and the linen cloths lying on the ground and the cloth which had been wrapped around Jesus’ head all folded up and lying in a different place. They went back home, amazed at what had happened. Until that moment they hadn’t understood that Jesus would rise from the dead.
