Church Re-opening For Private Prayer

The Church will be open from 11.00a.m. until 6.00p.m for Private Prayer each weekday and from 12.00noon until 6.00p.m. on Sundays.

The advice of the CMO is to stay at home where possible. However if you choose to visit the Church

- Please use the hand sanitizer provided as you enter and leave the Church.
- Practice good respiratory hygiene, that is, when coughing and sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue.
- Maintain physical distancing, that is, leave at least 2 metres (6 ½ feet) distance between yourself and other people, particularly those who are coughing or sneezing.
- If you are in the vulnerable group, feel unwell or are displaying symptoms, that is, cough, fever, sneezing etc. we ask that you **Stay at Home** and seek medical advice, this is the best way to minimise the risk of COVID-19 to our community.

We have no further information as to when public services may begin. Mass will continue to be broadcast over the internet on our Webcam 'Live Stream' at 10.00a.m. weekdays and 11.00a.m.on Sundays. Stay safe.
