Re-opening Church

- The church will re-open for Public weekday Mass at 10.00a.m. on Monday the 29th June.

- Our volunteers will be here to safely guide you to your seat and facilitate safe movement of people at Communion time.
- We would ask you to leave the church promptly after Mass to help with the cleaning process.
- We accept that reopening will be challenging and ask for your patience.
- People are asked to be personally responsible and observe social distancing and hygiene etiquette at all times.
