REOPENING OF CHURCH FOR PUBLIC SERVICE

Proceed in single file observing 2m. physical distancing

Fill seats from inside of pew first, starting at top of church.

Mass attendees should remain seated throughout

Receiving Holy Communion

Use centre aisle in single file (*Right side first – St. Vincent De-Paul Altar*) to receive Communion and return to your seat via side aisle – please note communion can only be received in your hand.

Exit Church promptly via side aisles only, observing guidelines to facilitate cleaning.
