DAY 2 – MONDAY OF HOLY WEEK

Jesus enters God's house, the Temple, and is very angry because a lot of people are not using it for prayer but to cheat and steal.



Challenge 2 - complete steps 1-3

3. Funny fact: during Lent the church gives up saying 'Alleluia' and the 'Gloria'. These prayers get packed away until Easter Sunday when they are 'set free' again to be used with great joy because Jesus has risen! Write out the words 'Alleluia' & 'Glory to God' (the whole Gloria if you like!) using bubble writing, colour them in and decorate them. Then find a box to pack them away in (decorate the box if you like). You could give up sweets & chocolate for this week and pack some sweets/chocolate in the box too for opening on EASTER SUNDAY!

Holy Monday Gospel

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew

Jesus went in to the Temple in Jerusalem and was very upset to see what was happening there; people were selling animals and



exchanging money. He threw out all the people who were buying and selling. He over turned the tables that belonged to the men who were exchanging different kinds of money. And he upset the benches of those who were selling doves & animals. He refused to allow anyone to carry goods through the Temple courts. He said to all the people gathered there, 'It is written in the Scriptures, 'My Temple will be a house of prayer'. But what have you done with it? You have turned it in to a hideout for robbers' and he drove them all out.
