You could use a small table or a window sill & place some holy objects in it e.g a candle, a bible, a little piece of greenery from the garden to represent Palm Sunday or one of the 'palm' crosses available at the back of the church. Holy Tuesday Gospel

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew

After Jesus had cleansed the Temple he went back to stay with his friends Mary, Martha & Lazarus in Bethany, near Jerusalem (Lazarus was the man he had raised from the dead). Early the next morning, Jesus and his disciples went back in to the city.



Jesus was very hungry and seeing a fig tree growing by the side of the road he stopped to pick some figs. However while the tree should have had figs it had only leaves. Jesus said to the tree, 'You will never again have fruit' and immediately the

tree dried up.

The disciples saw this and were amazed. 'How did the fig tree wither away so quickly?' they asked. Jesus answered, 'If you have faith and do not doubt, you will be able to do what I did to this tree.

And you will be able to do more. You will be able to say to this mountain 'fall into the sea'. And if you have faith, it will happen. If you believe, you will get anything you ask for in prayer.
