Palm Sunday Gospel A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke

Jesus went on to Jerusalem. When he got close, he sent two of his disciples on ahead and told them: 'Go in to next town. When you

enter it, you will see a donkey tied up. Untie it and bring it here to me. If anyone asks you why you are taking it, just say: the Master needs it and will send it back directly'.

The two disciples went in to the town and found the donkey just as Jesus had told them. While they were untying it, the owner came and asked them what they were doing. They gave him the answer Jesus had told them and the owner let them go.

They took the donkey back to Jesus, threw their cloaks on its back and he sat on it. Great crowds of people came out to greet him. They spread their cloaks on the road, others cut branches from the trees and spread them in his path or waved them, shouting 'Hosanna! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest heavens'.

Then some of the Pharisees in the crowd spoke to Jesus. 'Teacher', they said, 'tell your disciples to be quiet!' Jesus answered, 'I tell you that if they keep quiet, the very stones in the road will start to shout'.
