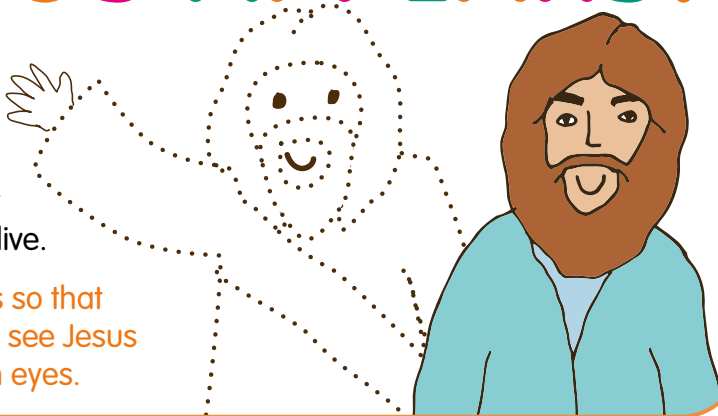
My name is _____

The disciples were afraid because they no longer had Jesus with them. They sat in a room with the doors locked.

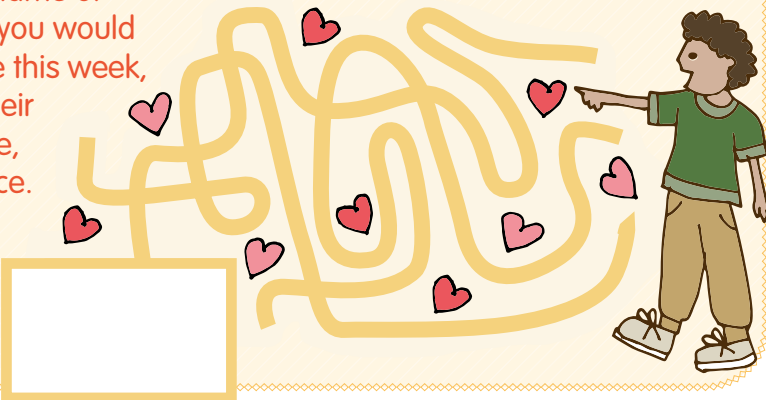


Match the right key to the right door so that the disciples can go and tell everyone the good news that Jesus is alive!

Visit loved ones

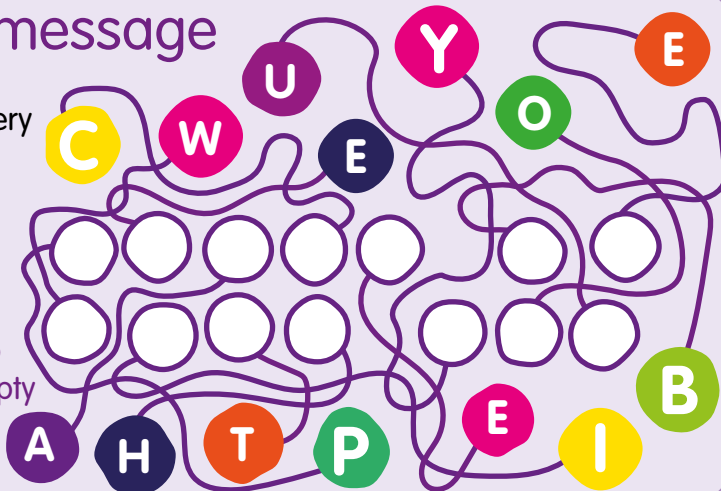
The disciples were so happy to see Jesus again.
