THOUGHT FOR THE DAY:

There are odd expressions in the Fourth Gospel and in 1 John. It is strange to be commanded to love. Even stranger: "Now by this we may be sure that we know him, if we obey his commandments." What can "command" and "obedience" have to do with the love, the most free thing of all? It may help to recall that both human nature and divine nature are defined by love. We are being commanded to become what we most want to be in our deepest selves. Obedience here is the invitation to become our truest selves, true to our identity before God and our true to our mission simply as human beings.

From Monday May 10th our Church will re-open for public Masses. Mass will be at 10.00am Monday to Saturday and at weekends the Vigil Mass will be at 5.30pm and Masses on Sunday will be at 9.15 and 11.00am.

Admission will be on a first-come first-served basis, volunteers will be in attendance to assist with stewarding and we are dependent on your understanding and co-operation.

Mass will also resume in Rosmini on Monday 10th May.

Daily Masses will take place from Monday – Saturday at 10am and on Sunday at 10.30 a.m. only. Numbers are confined to a maximum of 50 so please come early to avoid disappointment.

We urgently require volunteers to assist with the various tasks and we request if you have the time to please leave your name in at the sacristy

We look forward to welcoming you back.

For Funerals and Weddings the maximum number is capped at 50 in attendance. First Holy Communions and Confirmations are not permitted at present.
