MASS TIMES

Mass is at 10.00am Monday to Saturday and at weekends the Vigil Mass is at 5.30pm. Mass on Sundays is at 9.15 and 11.00am.

Mass Numbers continue to be restricted, social distancing will continue and attendees are asked to wear a face covering, use the hand sanitizers and leave their contact details in one of the safes for contact tracing.

Admission will be on a first-come first-served basis, volunteers will be in attendance to assist with stewarding and we are dependent on your understanding and co-operation.

Daily Mass will take place in St. Joseph's Rosmini from Monday – Saturday at 10am and on Sunday at 10.30 a.m. only. Numbers are also confined to a maximum of 50 so please come early.

For Funerals and Weddings the maximum number is capped at 50 in attendance. First Holy Communions and Confirmations are not permitted at present.
