EASING OF COVID OF COVID 19 RESTRICTIONS:

The government has stated that as and from Monday 6th September Religious services and ceremonies can proceed with 50% of venue capacity. However, in reality for this Church, because of the continued requirement to maintain 2 metre social distancing our increased capacity will be 16 spaces at the centre of the Church. We will still be required to use hand sanitizer, wear a mask and for the Church to be sanitised after services.
