## The 7 Special Meeting Times with God

Over the last 2 weeks we have been talking about Baptism, the time when you joined God's family of the church. Baptism is what we call a sacrament. The word 'sacrament' starts with the same first letters as the word 'sacred' (which means holy). This helps us to understand that a sacrament is something to do with God. In the Catholic Church to which you and I belong, we have 7 sacraments or 7 special meeting times with God when He blesses us and helps us to become better friends with Him. Here are the 7 sacraments:



As you can see the sacraments are Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation (Confession), Eucharist (Communion/Mass), Marriage, Holy Orders (becoming a priest) and the Sacrament of the Sick.

- How many of the sacraments have you received already? If you are in 2<sup>nd</sup> class of course you are getting ready to receive 2 sacraments for the very first time.
- Some Sacraments can be celebrated many times, you could even receive them every day like the Eucharist (Communion) or Reconciliation (Confession) but some like Baptism and Confirmation can only be received once in your life!
- 3 Sacraments are part of one group and are the ones we need to receive to become full members of the church. They are:
