Thought for the day

We can identify easily with the double expression “harassed and helpless”, a wide expression of frustration and naked need.

There can indeed be a sense of aimlessness, “like sheep without a shepherd”, as we look for direction in life, values to live by and a sense of overall meaning and purpose. Dennis O’Driscoll captured it in his poem Missing God:
