It was run by Tarsus Scripture School, a relatively new initiative by 3 Bible 'experts' - the Dean of Faculty of Theology in Maynooth University, Jessie Rogers, Fr Kieran O Mahony, an Augustinian Friar & Biblical scholar and Seán Goan, Lecturer in Biblical Theology, all excellent presenters. The Scripture School runs seasonal courses and is very accessible cost wise. You can attend their courses in-person or online or a combination of the two. Older courses of theirs can be accessed free of charge via their website tarsusscriptureschool.ie. Well worth checking out as an aide to helping with understanding the role of the Bible in our life of faith.
