Sr. Elizabeth lived for a time at Marino Green and while in Marino she devoted herself wholeheartedly to the Parish preparing children and adults for the sacraments and was a valued member of the Baptism Team as well as the Liturgy Group. She also found time to work in the St Vincent de Paul charity shop, deliver meals on wheels and visit the elderly in the parish. After 15 years of dedicated service to Marino parish, she returned to her community in England in 2016 where she passed away on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2023 R.I.P.
