THOUGHT FOR THE DAY:

When is an ending not an ending?

Mark takes the huge risk of an apparently negative ending to the story which began resoundingly in 1:1. The ending does not satisfy and never did...and that is Mark's very point.

To have a neat narrative ending would close the story in the past, whereas Mark forces us to realise that the story goes on in the lives of all disciples, then and now. We are the bearers of the Good News, we are the continuation of the story, a story which in truth will never really end, thanks be to God.
