**Scoil Mhuire – Confirmation:** Congratulations to the 57 boys from Scoil Mhuire who were confirmed on Friday here in the church in a very beautiful ceremony. They have been very committed to their preparation which has been on-going since they and their parents attended our information meeting and the Enrolment Mass back in October. Other preparation included the 8 week Nua Origins film programme, a Reconciliation Service, their monthly Masses and a retreat with NET Ministries. They will be taking on some volunteer work in the community post-Easter to show that they are now witnesses to Christ. We ask you to keep them in your prayers over the next few months.

**First Confessions & the service of Light for Confirmation:** The Parish Church is a hive of prayer and activity at the moment. with practices ongoing for both 2nd and 6th class groups. This week sees Communion children from Scoil Mhuire celebrate First Confession, Communion children and Confirmation children from schools other than Catholic celebrate Confession and the girls of St Vincent De Paul school take on more responsibility for their faith at The Service of Light.
