Thought for the day

What is distinctive about our faith as Christians? We do not believe in a system of ideas or even in a higher ethics: we believe in a person, who gives life “a new horizon and a decisive direction” (Benedict XVI). John’s Gospel makes this clear with its great I am sentences, one of which we hear today: “I am the gate.” Naturally, we think the gate to what? The gate to life to the full. The risk today is to set our expectations low, to be happy with less. But the Gospel calls not to be half alive, but to be fully alive. Let us enter by the gate himself, because the gate to life is always open.

Often, loving Lord, we find ourselves astray and defenceless. Let us recognise your voice, calling us one by one as you call us to follow you.

Foundation stone of our Church: On 2nd May 1926 the foundation stone of our Church was laid. We would like to remember this event, one hundred years later, by blessing the stone before the 5.30 pm Mass on Saturday 2nd May and before the 9.15am and 11am Masses on Sunday 3rd May. The blessing of the stone will mark the beginning of plans to mark the centenary of the opening of our Church which will occur in 2028. Parishioners are asked to assemble immediately before Mass for the Blessing.

First Communion: Warmest congratulations to the 44 First Communion Scoil Mhuire boys and girls celebrated First Communion here in the church on Friday. It was a very beautiful Mass and there was a great air of excitement in the church. This was the first time that the Scoil Mhuire group included both boys and girls.
